The Contractor is still delayed by the Railroad and the bore and jack of a 24° steel casing with a 16° Ductile for carrier pipe under the Railroad, at the intersection of Air Base Road and Lower Richland Boulevard, will begin when Railroad inspectors are available. Also, the Contractor will begin the installatic of an 18° HDPE Pipe by directional drilling on Air Base Road and the bore and jack of a 24° steel casing with a 16° carrier pipe at Cross Hill Road and Air Base Road.
