Richland County Government committed CDBG-R funds to four Projects. 1) Infill Housing Development is planned for a targeted area that will reduce the number of vacant lots by 4 in a residential zone; provide decent safe and most importantly affordable housing and the project will help to increase the property values for existing property owners. 2) The Infrastructure road construction project will greatly impact a five phased PUD that is undeveloped. The road paving activity will directly impact 16 homes that are currently accessed by a dirt road. 3) Public Service employment and training program for 25 youth between the ages of 14-19. Participants will be recruited from the Foster Care System and from at risk communities. The fourth activity is planning and general administration of the CDBG-R program.

Quarterly Activities/Project Description*		
<p>The data on jobs created funded by this grant has expired since the quarter. The current project underway is the road construction in the Rockgate subdivision. The subdivision is in phase III of development. The activity is 50% completed. During Phase II 16 homes were constructed on a dirt road being constructed. When completed 16 households will use this road daily and eventually 200 households will be impacted. During this quarter the contractor mobilized and stabilized the area so the project could begin. The planned road was cleared and graded. Davis Bacon reporting revealed that a total of ten laborers have been working on this project for a total of 1781.91 hours worked. In addition during this quarter predevelopment began for infill housing development. 4 properties were identified and notices were sent to owners along with information "When A Public Agency Acquires Your Property". Site specific environmental reviews began and will be completed when a wetlands determination is made on one of the sites. In addition, a Request for Qualifications for housing development teams was published December 6, 2009. The deadline for receiving responses is January 20, 2010. Finally during this quarter, a project sign was installed at the site of the infrastructure project to give notice that the project is the result of ARRA.</p>
