## Report of Actions

**Call To Order** – Paul Livingston, as requested by the Committee Chair, called the meeting to order at 6:00.

**Approval of Minutes** – The minutes of the May 28, 2002 Regular Session Meeting were approved as submitted.

**Adoption of Agenda** – The agenda was adopted as submitted.

### I. Items for Action

- Consent    **A. Legal: Ordinance Amendment re: Hazardous Waste Penalty** – The Committee recommended that Council give first reading approval to the recommended change for Chapter 13, Sections 13-2(b) and 13-13(a) of the Code of Ordinances, which is to delete references to specific editions of the various building codes, and increase the penalty amount up to \$500 for violations under the chapter
- Consent    **B. Legal: Ordinance Amendment re: Animal and Fowl Penalty** – The Committee recommended that Council give first reading approval to an ordinance amendment to Chapter 5, Animals and Fowl, to increase the penalty amount from \$200 to \$500 for violations under this chapter.
- Consent    **C. EMS: Domestic Preparedness Grant** – The Committee recommended that Council accept a grant award from the SC Dept. of Public Safety for equipment (a trailer and decontamination tent) to be used in the event of a Weapons of Mass Destruction or major contamination incident. The grant award is for \$15,000 with a match of \$5,000.
- Consent    **D. Public Works: Engineering Services** – The Committee recommended that Council authorize the Procurement Department to negotiate with the selected firms and to award contracts on a project-by-project basis provided the fee is within the budgeted amount.

### III. Items for Discussion / Information

- A. Conservation Commission: Bond Issuance** – The Committee referred this item back to staff to explore other sources of revenue and return a report with the findings back to the A&F Committee.
