**ITEMS FOR ACTION**

**2004 Roadway Resurfacing Project**

Mr. McEachern moved, seconded by Mr. Pearce, to approve an award of a construction contract in the amount of \$1,361,588.00 to Sloan Construction Company, Inc. for the resurfacing of approximately eleven (11) miles of paved roadway throughout Richland County. The vote in favor was unanimous.

**Northeast Transportation Study**

Mr. McEachern moved, seconded by Ms. Tillis, to adopt the study. The vote was in favor.

**Resurfacing of County-Owned Parking Lots**

Mr. Pearce moved, seconded by Mr. McEachern, to award a construction contract in the amount of \$168,897.90 for the resurfacing of two county-owned parking lots to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, C.R. Jackson, Inc. The vote in favor was unanimous.

**Purchase of Rubber Tire Backhoe**

Mr. McEachern moved, seconded by Ms. Tillis, to approve the purchase of a Caterpillar rubber tire backhoe/loader for the Roads and Drainage Division of the Department of Public Works. The vote in favor was unanimous.

**Purchase of Excavator**

Mr. McEachern moved, seconded by Mr. Pearce, to approve the purchase of a 34-ton Caterpillar excavator from Blanchard Caterpillar for the Roads and Drainage Division of the Department of Public Works. The vote in favor was unanimous.
