1 CALL TO ORDER - Chairwoman Jesica Mackey called the meeting to order at approximately 4:00 PM.

a. <u>Fiscal Year 25 Grant Application</u> – Assistant County Administrator Lori Thomas stated that 69 applications were received. Of those, 13 were deemed ineligible. The total requested amount is \$2,924,510, with \$658,800 available.
