Voters will be asked to provide one of the following Photo IDs when voting in person. S.C. Driver's License

- S.C. Department of Motor Vehicles ID Card

- S.C Voter Registration Card with Photo
- Federal Military ID
  - o Includes all Department of Defense Photo IDs and Veterans Affairs Benefits Card
- U.S. Passport
  - Includes US Passport ID Card

If you have one of these Photo IDs, you are ready to vote. Voters should remember to bring one of these IDs with them to the polling place. Voters without Photo ID can get one free of charge from the Department of Motor Vehicles or their county voter registration office. For more information on Photo ID, visit scVOTES.gov or contact your county board of voter registration and elections.

<u>Absentee Voting</u>: Registered electors who cannot vote in person on the day of the election and who will be out of the county for the duration of early voting may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot.
