PROJECT OVERVIEW

As part of the Richland County Transportation Penny Program, Richland County is proposing improvements along the Broad River Road Corridor, between St. Andrews Road and the Broad River Road Bridge. Potential improvements along the Broad River Road Corridor that we are seeking public input on include:

- · Improvements at three intersections St. Andrews Road, Bush River Road, Greystone Boulevard
- · Streetscape and Pedestrian Accommodations at each of the above listed intersections
- · Various landscaped medians throughout the corridor
- · Consolidation of overhead utilities
- Pedestrian lighting from the Broad River Road Bridge to St. Andrews Road

PROJECT PATH FORWARD

After the close of the comment period on March 22, 2019, the project team will review and consider all comments received and develop an Improvement Prioritization List. The information gathered from additional design studies, along with your input will be used to assist with selecting the final design for the proposed improvements.

Advance Project Design: 2019
Begin Property Negotiations: Early 2020
Begin Construction: Late 2020
