FAILURE TO LICENSE YOUR DOG OR CAT CAN RESULT IN A MAXIMUM PENALTY OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING THIRTY (30) DAYS OR BOTH. (ADDITIONAL COURT COST AND FEES MAY APPLY).

If one of the following classifications applies to your pet, you are exempt from paying the higher license fee for fertile pets. You will be required to pay a fee of \$4.21 for each license. You will not be required to have your pet spayed/neutered.

- □ Not spayed or neutered due to medical reasons. (MUST PROVIDE A WRITTEN STATEMENT FROM A LICENSED VETERINARIAN)
- A purebred pet that has participated in a recognized conformation or performance event within the last twelve (12) months. (PROOF OF PARTICIPATION MUST BE PROVIDED)
- □ Dog(s) used for hunting purposes. (MUST PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION THAT THE DOG IS PROPERLY REGISTERED WITH A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED ORGANIZATION WHICH SANCTIONS HUNTING TESTS AND/OR FIELD TRIALS)

Any owner of a dog which is trained to be an assistance dog for its owner shall be required to obtain an annual license but shall not be required to pay the license fee. (PROOF MUST BE SUBMITTED).

- 1. Copy of your rabies vaccination certificate (from a licensed veterinarian).

The County license fee for fertile pets is twenty-one dollars and seven cents (\$21.07) per year. The fee for sterilized pets is four dollars and twenty-one cents (\$4.21) per year.								
You will be provided with an identification tag that must be worn by your pet at all times. Licenses expire one year after the date of issue. Thirty days prior to your expiration date you will be sent a renewal form. Failure to license or renew your pet's license is a violation of the Richland County Code of Ordinance , Section 5-2 .								
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
