After relocating to Columbia, South Carolina she transferred to the Army National Guard and earned the rank of Captain prior to medical retirement; and

WHEREAS, during Julianne "Judy" Scott's stint in the military she was deployed to Saudi Arabia during the Operation Desert Shield/Operation Desert Storm war, where she received a Bronze Star for meritorious achievement, service and combat heroism.

Several years later she became a life member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars. Within the year she was elected to serve as the 1st female District 1 Jr. Vice Commander, as well as 2nd female VFW Post 4262's Jr. Vice Commander. She served in these capacities up to and including becoming the Commander for the District and the Post 3 years later.

WHEREAS, Julianne "Judy" Scott served as the 1st nationally appointed Certified National Recruiter for the State of South Carolina. She was the oldest National Recruiter and one of three females in the country. She opened the door so that age was not a factor in selecting recruiters, but that veterans of all ages could be appointed. As a result, selections throughout the country were then made based on willingness to serve.

WHEREAS, Julianne "Judy" Scott has been a dedicated volunteer. She has been a member of the American Red Cross and volunteered in New York during the World Trade Disaster, in Florida, Texas and Louisiana during the devastating hurricanes. Most recently she served in Haiti in 2008 on a medical mission. Presently she is the Disaster Health Services Lead and the Staff Health Nurse for Central South Carolina;

WHEREAS, Julianne "Judy" Scott is a life member of the Disabled American Veterans, American legion and served as the national Vice Commander of the Women Veterans of America;

WHEREAS, Julianne "Judy" Scott is currently employed as the school Nurse at Columbia High School and has no immediate plans of retiring. She will be 70 in August and her plan is to skydive to celebrate her upcoming birthday.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Richland County Council does hereby commend and applaud the lifelong commitment of service by Julianne "Judy" Scott and is proud to have her as a resident of Richland County, South Carolina.
